AUSTRALIA - Teusner "Joshua" GSM blend - a stunning Barossa newcomer known for the concentration of his wines. **Adams Family Shiraz** - 50% Clare Valley and 50% Barossa, a brilliant wine from a brilliant producer. **Greenock Creek Roenfeldt Road Shiraz** - the ultimate Aussie cult wine, extremely rare.

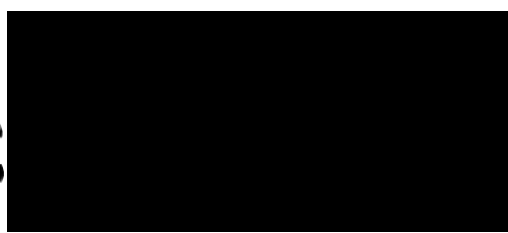
GERMANY - Dr. Thanisch 2001 Riesling Kabinett - one of the most respected producers of Riesling from a classic vintage. **Joh. Jos. Prüm Wehlener Spätlese 2001** - the manager's favorite! Fresh, floral aromas and an extensive passion fruit palate. A benchmark for German wines.

ITALY - Castel de Paolis (Lazio, Italy) - this is wine writer Burton Anderson's favorite Frascati. The addition of Viognier grapes is responsible for its superior quality. **Fattoria La Massa** - this Tuscan wine by Giampaolo Motta has won more than 8 consecutive awards from Gambero Rosso (Italy's Wine Spectator). We are very fortunate to receive a small allocation.

PORTUGAL - Quinta do Infantado Port. This Quinta was the first to produce a single grape (Touriga Nacional) vintage Port. Their vineyards are all ranked class "A", the highest grade, by the Port Wine Institute.

SPAIN - CVNE Rioja - one of the oldest, most traditional Spanish wine estates. An outstanding producer.

USA - Carlisle "Three Birds" - a stunning new producer making some of the best Rhône-style wines in America today.
